A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to extend the special survivor indemnity allowance to survivors of certain members of the Armed Forces who die on active duty.

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION TO SURVIVORS OF CERTAIN MEM-**
2 **BERS WHO DIE ON ACTIVE DUTY OF SPECIAL**
3 **SURVIVOR INDEMNITY ALLOWANCE FOR PER-**
4 **SONS AFFECTED BY REQUIRED SURVIVOR**
5 **BENEFIT PLAN ANNUITY OFFSET FOR DE-**
6 **PENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COMPENSATION.**

7 (a) EXTENSION.—Subsection (m) of section 1450 of
8 title 10, United States Code, as added by section 644 of
9 the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
10 2008 (Public Law 110–181; 122 Stat. 158), is amended
11 in paragraph (1)(B) by striking “section 1448(a)(1) of
12 this title” and inserting “subsection (a)(1) of section 1448
13 of this title or by reason of coverage under subsection (d)
14 of such section”.

15 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.—The amendment
16 made by subsection (a) shall apply with respect to the
17 month beginning on October 1, 2008, and subsequent
18 months as provided by paragraph (6) of subsection (m)
19 of section 1450 of title 10, United States Code, as added
20 by section 644 of the National Defense Authorization Act
21 for Fiscal Year 2008.
