3 **SECTION 1. PRIVATE FIRST CLASS DAVID H. SHARRETT II**
4 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 10449 White Granite Drive in
7 Oakton, Virginia, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Private First Class David H. Sharrett II Post Office
2 Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Private First Class
7 David H. Sharrett II Post Office Building”.
