2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SERGEANT HENRY YBARRA III POST OFFICE**
2 **BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 3903 South Congress Avenue in
5 Austin, Texas, shall be known and designated as the “Ser-
6 geant Henry Ybarra III Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant Henry
11 Ybarra III Post Office Building”.

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
