A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to extend the compliance period for persons subject to the renewable fuel mandate in the years 2008, 2009, and 2010.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SPECIAL RULE FOR RENEWABLE FUEL DEFI-4 CITS IN 2008, 2009, AND 2010. Section 211(o)(5) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 5 7545(o)(5)) is amended by adding immediately before paragraph (6) the following: 8 "(F) SPECIAL RULE FOR RENEWABLE 9 FUEL DEFICITS IN CALENDAR YEARS 2008, 2009,

AND 2010.—In applying subparagraph (D) to a

renewable fuel deficit in calendar year 2008, 2 2009, or 2010, a carry-forward period of 3 calendar years following the year in which the renewable fuel deficit is created may be used in lieu of the 1-calendar year carry-forward period referred to in subparagraph (D).".
