To amend title 23, United States Code, to prohibit the collection of certain tolls on existing high occupancy vehicles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Free Way Act of
5 2008”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF TOLL COLLECTION ON CERTAIN**
7 **HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLES.**

8 Section 166(b)(4) of title 23, United States Code, is
9 amended by striking “The” and inserting the following:
10 “Except in the case of high occupancy vehicles that were

1 permitted to use a HOV facility in a State at no cost be-
2 fore December 31, 2007, the”.
