A BILL

To clarify the use of Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants for corrections and community corrections programs, to enhance the data made available by the National Adult and Juvenile Offender Reentry Resource Center, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Delivering Effective
5 Training and Enforcement Resources (DETER) Act of
6 2008”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF AUTHORIZED USES OF EDWARD**
2 **BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE**
3 **GRANTS.**

4 Subparagraph (D) of section 501(a)(1) of the Omni-
5 bus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42
6 U.S.C. 3751(a)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

7 “(D) Corrections and community correc-
8 tions programs, which may include—

9 “(i) using global positioning moni-
10 toring technologies to monitor individuals
11 on parole and probation; and

12 “(ii) hiring additional parole offi-
13 cers.”.

14 **SEC. 3. NATIONAL ADULT AND JUVENILE OFFENDER RE-**
15 **ENTRY RESOURCE CENTER.**

16 Paragraph (3) of section 2976(m) of the Omnibus
17 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (as amended
18 by Public Law 110-199) (42 U.S.C. 3797w) is amended—

19 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (G)
20 through (I) as subparagraphs (I) through (K), re-
21 spectively; and

22 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (F) the fol-
23 lowing new subparagraphs:

24 “(G) collect and disseminate information
25 related to Federal and State laws relevant to
26 parole and probation agencies and officers;

1 “(H) collect and disseminate information
2 on available Federal and State grants for parole
3 and probation agencies and officers;”.
