A BILL

To convey the New River State Park campground located in the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area in the Jefferson National Forest in Carroll County, Virginia, to the Commonwealth of Virginia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE.**

4 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the
5 Interior shall convey, without consideration, to the Com-
6 monwealth of Virginia, all right, title, and interest of the

1 United States in and to the federally owned land under
2 jurisdiction of the Secretary consisting of the approxi-
3 mately 78.15 acres (and all buildings and amenities within
4 those acres) located in the Mount Rogers National Recre-
5 ation Area in the Jefferson National Forest in Carroll
6 County, Virginia, as generally depicted on the map titled
7 “Potential Conveyance of the New River Campground to
8 the Commonwealth of Virginia”, dated May 1, 2008.

9 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
10 and legal description of the land to be conveyed under sub-
11 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory
12 to the Secretary. The cost of the survey and all other costs
13 incurred by the Secretary to convey the land shall be borne
14 by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

15 (c) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE, USE OF CONVEYED
16 LAND.—The conveyance authorized under subsection (a)
17 shall be subject to the condition that the Commonwealth
18 of Virginia accept the real property described in such sub-
19 section in its condition at the time of conveyance (com-
20 monly known as conveyance “as is”).

21 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
22 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
23 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection

1 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
2 interests of the United States.

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
