## A BILL

To provide funding for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Warm in Winter and  
5 Cool in Summer Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE APPRO-**  
7 **PRIATIONS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—In addition to any amounts ap-  
9 propriated under any other provision of Federal law, there

1 is appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not oth-  
2 erwise appropriated, for fiscal year 2008—

3           (1) \$1,265,000,000 (to remain available until  
4           expended) for making payments under subsections  
5           (a) through (d) of section 2604 of the Low-Income  
6           Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C.  
7           8623); and

8           (2) \$1,265,000,000 (to remain available until  
9           expended) for making payments under section  
10          2604(e) of the Low-Income Home Energy Assist-  
11          ance Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C. 8623(e)), notwith-  
12          standing the designation requirement of section  
13          2602(e) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 8621(e)).

14          (b) EMERGENCY REQUIREMENT.—The amount pro-  
15          vided under this section is designated as an emergency re-  
16          quirement and necessary to meet emergency needs, pursu-  
17          ant to section 204 of S. Con. Res. 21 (110th Congress),  
18          the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year  
19          2008.
