

In the Senate of the United States,

September 25 (legislative day, September 17), 2008.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 6460) entitled “An Act to amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to provide for the remediation of sediment contamination in areas of concern, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike section 3(f) and all that follows and insert the following:

1 (f) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section*
2 *118(c)(12)(H) of such Act (33 U.S.C. 1268(c)(12)(H)) is*
3 *amended—*

4 (1) *by striking clause (i) and inserting the fol-*
5 *lowing:*

6 “(i) *IN GENERAL.—In addition to*
7 *other amounts authorized under this sec-*
8 *tion, there is authorized to be appropriated*
9 *to carry out this paragraph \$50,000,000 for*

1 *each of fiscal years 2004 through 2010.”;*

2 *and*

3 *(2) by adding at the end the following:*

4 *“(iii) ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.—Not*
5 *more than 20 percent of the funds appro-*
6 *priated pursuant to clause (i) for a fiscal*
7 *year may be used to carry out subpara-*
8 *graph (F).”.*

9 *(g) PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM.—Section*
10 *118(c)(13)(B) of such Act (33 U.S.C. 1268(c)(13)(B)) is*
11 *amended by striking “2008” and inserting “2010”.*

12 **SEC. 4. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.**

13 *Section 106(b) of the Great Lakes Legacy Act of 2002*
14 *(33 U.S.C. 1271a(b)) is amended by striking paragraph (1)*
15 *and inserting the following:*

16 *“(1) IN GENERAL.—In addition to any amounts*
17 *authorized under other provisions of law, there is au-*
18 *thorized to be appropriated to carry out this section*
19 *\$3,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 through*
20 *2010.”.*
