SECTION 1. EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR GROWERS AND 2 FIRST HANDLERS OF TOMATOES. 3 (a) Emergency Assistance.—There is hereby ap-4 propriated to the Secretary of Agriculture \$100,000,000, 5 to be available until expended, to make payments to growers and first handlers, as defined by the Secretary, of fresh 6 7 tomatoes that experienced crop or market losses, or both, 8 as a result of the Food and Drug Administration Public 9 Health Advisory issued on June 7, 2008. (b) PAYMENT AMOUNT.—The amount of the pay-10 ment made to a grower or first handler under this section 11 12 shall not exceed 75 percent of the greater of— 13 (1) the value of the unmarketed tomatoes; and 14 (2) the actual loss incurred by the grower or handler. 15

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
