Mr. RODRIGUEZ (for himself, Mr. GONZALEZ, and Mr. SMITH of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 2007 to provide for reimbursement for costs incurred by the non-Federal interest in the flood control project in San Antonio, Texas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SAN ANTONIO CHANNEL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS.**

4 Section 3154 of the Water Resources Development
5 Act of 2007 (Public Law 110–114; 121 Stat. 1148) is
6 amended—

1 (1) by striking “The project for flood control”
2 and inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—The project for
3 flood control”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(b) REIMBURSEMENT.—Subject to the availability
6 of funds, the non-Federal interest shall be reimbursed for
7 costs incurred by the non-Federal interest that exceed the
8 non-Federal share of project costs.

9 “(c) CASH CONTRIBUTIONS.—The Secretary shall ac-
10 cept funds provided by the non-Federal interest for use
11 in carrying out planning, engineering, design, and con-
12 struction for the project. The Federal share of such plan-
13 ning, engineering, design, and construction carried out
14 with non-Federal contributions shall be credited against
15 the non-Federal share of the cost of the project.”.

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
