## A BILL

To amend Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003 to expand the areas of Federal land on which hazardous fuel reduction projects may be conducted under that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Healthy Forests Res-  
5 toration Amendments Act of 2008”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF FEDERAL LAND ELIGIBLE FOR HAZ-**  
2 **ARDOUS FUEL REDUCTION PROJECTS.**

3 Section 102(a) of the Healthy Forests Restoration  
4 Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C. 6512(a)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “condition  
6 class 3 Federal land” and inserting “Federal land”;  
7 and

8 (2) by striking paragraphs (3) and (4) and in-  
9 serting the following new paragraphs:

10 “(3) Federal land that is described as condition  
11 class 2 or condition class 3;

12 “(4) Federal land on which there is windthrow,  
13 blowdown, or ice storm damage or an infestation of  
14 disease or insects; and”.
