# A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to authorize grants for Presidential Centers of Historical Excellence.

6	an eligible entity establishes that such entity—

8	President covered under paragraph (1),
9	historical works and collections of histor-
10	ical sources that the Commission considers
11	appropriate for preserving, publishing, or
12	otherwise recording at the public expense;
13	"(ii) has appropriate facilities and
14	space for preservation of, and public access
15	to, the historical works and collections of
16	historical sources;
17	"(iii) shall ensure preservation of, and
18	public access to, such historical works and
19	collections of historical sources at no
20	charge to the public;
21	"(iv) has educational programs that
22	make the use of such documents part of
23	the mission of such entity;
24	"(v) has raised funds from non-Fed-
25	eral sources in support of the efforts of the

1	entity to promote the historical preserva-
2	tion of, and public access to, such histor-
3	ical works and collections of historical
4	sources in an amount equal to the amount
5	of the grant the entity seeks under this
6	subsection;
7	"(vi) shall coordinate with any rel-
8	evant Federal program or activity, includ-
9	ing programs and activities relating to
10	Presidential archival depositories;
11	"(vii) shall coordinate with any rel-
12	evant non-Federal program or activity, in-
13	cluding programs and activities conducted
14	by State and local governments and private
15	educational historical entities; and
16	"(viii) has a workable plan for pre-
17	serving and providing public access to such
18	historical works and collections of histor-
19	ical sources.".

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
