AN ACT

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to extend
the pilot program for alternative water source projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Healthy Communities
3 Water Supply Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER**
5 **SOURCE PROJECTS.**

6 (a) SELECTION OF PROJECTS.—Section 220(d)(2) of
7 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
8 1300(d)(2)) is amended by inserting before the period at
9 the end the following: “or whether the project is located
10 in an area which is served by a public water system serving
11 10,000 individuals or fewer”.

12 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
13 220(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33
14 U.S.C. 1300(j)) is amended by striking “\$75,000,000 for
15 fiscal years 2002 through 2004” and inserting
16 “\$125,000,000”.

17 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF FUNDS.**

18 None of the funds authorized by this Act, including
19 the amendments made by this Act, may be used—

20 (1) to lobby or retain a lobbyist for the purpose
21 of influencing a Federal, State, or local govern-
22 mental entity or officer; or

1 (2) to pay for expenses related to the member-
2 ship of any individual or entity in an organization or
3 association.
