2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Healthy Communities
3 Water Supply Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER**
5 **SOURCE PROJECTS.**

6 Section 220(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control
7 Act (33 U.S.C. 1300(j)) is amended by striking
8 “\$75,000,000 for fiscal years 2002 through 2004” and
9 inserting “\$125,000,000”.
