A BILL

To designate a portion of the Rappahannock River in the State of Virginia as the “John W. Warner Rapids”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JOHN W. WARNER RAPIDS, FREDRICKSBURG,**
4 **VIRGINIA.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The portion of the Rappahan-
6 nock River comprised of the manmade rapids located at
7 the site of the former Embry Dam in Fredricksburg, Vir-
8 ginia, and centered at the coordinates of N. 38.32180 lati-

1 tude, W. 077.49049 longitude, shall be known and des-
2 ignated as the “John W. Warner Rapids”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the portion of the Rappahannock River referred
6 to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to
7 the John W. Warner Rapids.

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
