## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense, Secretary of State, Secretary of the Interior, and the Administrator of the United States Agency for International Development to provide to Congress copies and descriptions of contracts and task orders in excess of \$5,000,000 for work to be performed in Iraq and Afghanistan.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Iraq and Afghanistan
- 5 Contractor Sunshine Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE TO CONGRESS COPIES
- 7 AND DESCRIPTIONS OF CONTRACTS AND
- 8 TASK ORDERS IN EXCESS OF \$5,000,000 FOR
- 9 WORK TO BE PERFORMED IN IRAQ AND AF-
- 10 GHANISTAN.
- 11 (a) Monthly Requirement Regarding New Con-
- 12 TRACTS AND TASK ORDERS.—Each month, the Secretary
- 13 of Defense, the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the
- 14 Interior, and the Administrator of the United States
- 15 Agency for International Development shall provide to the
- 16 chairman and to the ranking minority member of each of
- 17 the committees of Congress specified in subsection (c) a
- 18 copy of, and a description of the work to be performed
- 19 under, each new contract, and each new task order issued
- 20 under an existing contract, in an amount greater than
- 21 \$5,000,000 entered into by the Department of Defense,
- 22 the Department of State, the Department of the Interior,
- 23 and the Agency for International Development, respec-
- 24 tively, during the preceding month for work to be per-
- 25 formed in Iraq and Afghanistan.

- 1 (b) REQUIREMENT REGARDING CONTRACTS AND
- 2 Task Orders Before Enactment.—Not later than
- 3 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
- 4 Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of State, the Secretary
- 5 of the Interior, and the Administrator of the United States
- 6 Agency for International Development shall provide to the
- 7 chairman and to the ranking minority member of each of
- 8 the committees of Congress specified in subsection (c) a
- 9 copy of, and a description of the work performed or to
- 10 be performed under, each contract, and each task order
- 11 issued under an existing contract, in an amount greater
- 12 than \$5,000,000 entered into by the Department of De-
- 13 fense, the Department of State, the Department of the
- 14 Interior, and the Agency for International Development,
- 15 respectively, during the period beginning October 1, 2001,
- 16 and ending on the last day of the month during which
- 17 this Act is enacted for work to be performed in Iraq and
- 18 Afghanistan.
- 19 (c) Committees.—The committees referred to in
- 20 subsections (a) and (b) are the following:
- 21 (1) The Committees on Armed Services, Over-
- sight and Government Reform, Appropriations, and
- Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives.

1	(2) The Committees on Armed Services, Home-
2	land Security and Governmental Affairs, Appropria-
3	tions, and Foreign Relations of the Senate.
4	(d) Form of Submissions.—The copies and de-
5	scriptions required by subsections (a) and (b) shall be sub-
6	mitted in unclassified form but may contain a classified
7	annex.
8	SEC. 3. REPORTS ON IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN CONTRACTS.
9	The Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of State, the
10	Secretary of the Interior, and the Administrator of the
11	United States Agency for International Development shall
12	each submit to Congress a report not later than 60 days
13	after the date of the enactment of this Act that contains
14	the following information:
15	(1) The number of persons performing work in
16	Iraq and Afghanistan under contracts (and sub-
17	contracts at any tier) entered into by Department of
18	Defense, the Department of State, the Department
19	of the Interior, and the United States Agency for
20	International Development, respectively.
21	(2) The total cost of such contracts.
22	(3) The total number of persons who have been
23	wounded or killed in performing work under such
24	contracts.

- 1 (4) A description of laws that have been broken 2 in the performance of such contracts, including laws 3 of Iraq and Afghanistan, international law, and Fed-4 eral law.
  - (5) A description of the disciplinary actions that have been taken against persons performing work under such contracts by the contractor, the United States Government, or the Government of Iraq or Afghanistan.
