A BILL

To establish the Land Between the Rivers National Heritage Area in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Land Between the Riv-
- 5 ers Southern Illinois National Heritage Area Act of
- 6 2007".
- 7 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 8 Congress finds that—

- 1 (1) southern Illinois has a cohesive, distinctive, 2 and important landscape that distinguishes the area 3 as worthy of designation as a National Heritage 4 Area;
 - (2) the historic features of southern Illinois reflect a period during which the area was the strategic convergence point during the westward expansion of the United States;
 - (3) the geographic centrality of southern Illinois ensured that the area played a pivotal military, social, and political role during the Civil War, which resulted in the area being known as the "Confluence of Freedom";
 - (4) southern Illinois is at the junction of the ending glaciers and 6 ecological divisions;
 - (5) after the expeditions of Lewis and Clark, the land between the rivers became known as "Egypt" because of the rivers in, and the beauty and agricultural abundance of, the area;
 - (6) Native Americans described the area in southern Illinois between the Mississippi and Ohio Rivers as the "Land Between the Rivers";
 - (7) a feasibility study led by the Office of Economic and Regional Development at Southern Illinois University Carbondale that was revised in April

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- 1 2006 documents a sufficient assemblage of nation-2 ally distinctive historic resources to demonstrate the 3 feasibility of, and the need for, establishing the 4 Land Between the Rivers National Heritage Area; 5 and 6 (8) stakeholders participating in the feasibility 7 study process for the Heritage Area have developed 8 a proposed management entity and financial plan to 9 preserve the natural, cultural, historic, and scenic 10 features of the area while furthering recreational 11 and educational opportunities in the area. 12 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS. 13 In this Act: 14 (1) Heritage Area.—The term "Heritage Area" means the Land Between the Rivers National 15 16 Heritage Area established by section 4(a).
- 17 (2) MANAGEMENT ENTITY.—The term "man-18 agement entity" means the management entity for 19 the Heritage Area designated by section 4(c).
- (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
 the Secretary of the Interior.
- 22 (4) STATE.—The term "State" means the State of Illinois.

3	(a) Establishment.—There is established in the
4	State the Land Between the Rivers National Heritage

6	(b) Boundaries.—The Heritage Area shall in-

9	Kaskaskia, Fort Massac, Wilkinsonville Contonment
10	the Lewis and Clark Sculpture, Flat Boat, Cave-in-
11	Rock, the Shawneetown Bank Building, the Iron
12	Furnace, the Crenshaw "Slave House," Roots
13	House, the site of the Lincoln-Douglas debate, cer-
14	tain sites associated with John A. Logan, the Fort
15	Defiance Planning Map, Mound City National Ceme-
16	tery, and Riverlore Mansion; and
17	(2) any other sites in Randolph, Perry, Jeffer-
18	son, Franklin, Hamilton, White, Jackson,
19	Williamson, Saline, Gallatin, Union, Johnson, Pope
20	Hardin, Alexander, Pulaski, and Massac Counties in
21	the State that the Secretary, in consultation with

the management entity, determine to be appropriate

for inclusion in the Heritage Area.

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- 1 (c) Management Entity.—The management entity
- 2 for the Heritage Area shall be the Southern Illinois Uni-

3 versity Carbondale.

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
