Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 312) revising the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2008, establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2009, and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2010 through 2013.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
2 eration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 312)
3 revising the congressional budget for the United States
4 Government for fiscal year 2008, establishing the congress-
5 sional budget for the United States Government for fiscal
6 year 2009, and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels
7 for fiscal years 2010 through 2013. The first reading of
8 the concurrent resolution shall be dispensed with. All
9 points of order against consideration of the concurrent
10 resolution are waived. General debate shall not exceed four
11 hours, with three hours confined to the congressional
12 budget equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
13 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Budget
14 and one hour on the subject of economic goals and policies
15 equally divided and controlled by Representative Maloney
16 of New York and Representative Saxton of New Jersey
17 or their designees. After general debate the concurrent
18 resolution shall be considered for amendment under the
19 five-minute rule. The concurrent resolution shall be con-
20 sidered as read. No amendment shall be in order except
21 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
22 companying this resolution. Each amendment may be of-
23 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
24 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
25 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-

1 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by a pro-
2 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
3 amendment. All points of order against the amendments
4 printed in the report are waived except that the adoption
5 of an amendment in the nature of a substitute shall con-
6 stitute the conclusion of consideration of the concurrent
7 resolution for amendment. After the conclusion of consid-
8 eration of the concurrent resolution for amendment, the
9 Committee shall rise and report the concurrent resolution
10 to the House with such amendment as may have been
11 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
12 dered on the concurrent resolution and amendments there-
13 to to final adoption without intervening motion except
14 amendments offered by the chairman of the Committee
15 on the Budget pursuant to section 305(a)(5) of the Con-
16 gressional Budget Act of 1974 to achieve mathematical
17 consistency. The concurrent resolution shall not be subject
18 to a demand for division of the question of its adoption.

19 SEC. 2. After a motion that the Committee rise has
20 been rejected on a legislative day, the Chair may entertain
21 another such motion on that day only if offered by the
22 chairman of the Committee on the Budget or the Majority
23 Leader or a designee. After a motion to strike out the
24 resolving words of the concurrent resolution (as described
25 in clause 9 of rule XVIII) has been rejected, the Chair

1 may not entertain another such motion during further
2 consideration of the concurrent resolution.

3 SEC. 3. During consideration in the House of House
4 Concurrent Resolution 312 pursuant to this resolution,
5 notwithstanding the operation of the previous question,
6 the Chair may postpone further consideration of the con-
7 current resolution to such time as may be designated by
8 the Speaker.

9 SEC. 4. After adoption of House Concurrent Resolu-
10 tion 312, it shall be in order to take from the Speaker's
11 table Senate Concurrent Resolution 70 and to consider the
12 Senate concurrent resolution in the House. All points of
13 order against the Senate concurrent resolution and
14 against its consideration are waived. It shall be in order
15 to move to strike all after the resolving clause of the Sen-
16 ate concurrent resolution and to insert in lieu thereof the
17 provisions of House Concurrent Resolution 312 as adopted
18 by the House. All points of order against that motion are
19 waived.
