Ms. CASTOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5818) to authorize the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to make loans to States to acquire foreclosed housing and to make grants to States for related costs.

Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider ation of the bill (H.R. 5818) to authorize the Secretary
of Housing and Urban Development to make loans to

1 States to acquire foreclosed housing and to make grants to States for related costs. The first reading of the bill 2 3 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-4 eration of the bill are waived except those arising under 5 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-6 7 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-8 ity member of the Committee on Financial Services. After 9 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment 10 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under 11 12 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-13 stitute recommended by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the bill. The committee amendment 14 15 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of order against the committee amendment in 16 17 the nature of a substitute are waived except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 18 19 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the committee amend-20ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except 21 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-22 companying this resolution. Each such amendment may 23 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may 24 be offered only by a Member designated in the report, 25 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time

specified in the report equally divided and controlled by 1 2 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to 3 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-4 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee 5 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendments 6 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of 7 rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill 8 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the 9 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been 10 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of 11 12 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in 13 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto 14 15 to final passage without intervening motion except one motion to recommit with or without instructions. 16

17 SEC. 2. After a motion that the Committee rise has been rejected on a legislative day, the Chair may entertain 18 another such motion on that day only if offered by the 19 20chairman of the Committee on Financial Services or the 21 Majority Leader or a designee. After a motion to strike 22 out the enacting words of the bill (as described in clause 23 9 of rule XVIII) has been rejected, the Chair may not 24 entertain another such motion during further consideration of the bill. 25

SEC. 3. During consideration in the House of H.R.
5818 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
designated by the Speaker.
