Ms. SUTTON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3021) to direct the Secretary of Education to make grants and low-interest loans to local educational agencies for the construction, modernization, or repair of public kindergarten, elementary, and secondary educational facilities, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 3021) to direct the Secretary of  
3 Education to make grants and low-interest loans to local  
4 educational agencies for the construction, modernization,  
5 or repair of public kindergarten, elementary, and sec-  
6 ondary educational facilities, and for other purposes. The  
7 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
8 of order against consideration of the bill are waived except  
9 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General  
10 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
11 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
12 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Edu-  
13 cation and Labor. After general debate the bill shall be  
14 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It  
15 shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the  
16 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the  
17 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by  
18 the Committee on Education and Labor now printed in  
19 the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
20 stitute shall be considered as read. All points of order  
21 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
22 stitute are waived except those arising under clause 10  
23 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no  
24 amendment to the committee amendment in the nature  
25 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in

1 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this  
2 resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only in  
3 the order printed in the report, may be offered only by  
4 a Member designated in the report, shall be considered  
5 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the  
6 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and  
7 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall  
8 not be subject to a demand for division of the question  
9 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points  
10 of order against such amendments are waived except those  
11 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion  
12 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
13 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
14 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may  
15 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
16 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
17 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.  
18 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
19 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without  
20 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
21 or without instructions.

22       SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.  
23 3021 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-  
24 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone

- 1 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
- 2 designated by the Speaker.
