## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5724) to implement the United States-Colombia Trade Promotion Agreement.

2 it shall be in order to immediately consider in the House  
3 the bill (H.R. 5724) to implement the United States-Co-  
4 lombia Trade Promotion Agreement. All points of order  
5 against consideration of the bill are waived except those  
6 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The bill shall  
7 be considered as read. All points of order against the bill  
8 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as  
9 ordered on the bill to final passage without intervening  
10 motion except four hours of debate equally divided and
