Ms. CASTOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6052) to promote increased public transportation use, to promote increased use of alternative fuels in providing public transportation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 6052) to promote increased public
6 transportation use, to promote increased use of alternative

1 fuels in providing public transportation, and for other pur-
2 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
3 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
4 waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule
5 XXI. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall
6 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
7 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
8 on Transportation and Infrastructure. After general de-
9 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
10 five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. All
11 points of order against provisions in the bill are waived.
12 Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment
13 to the bill shall be in order except those printed in the
14 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
15 lution. Each such amendment may be offered only in the
16 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-
17 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
18 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
19 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
20 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
21 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
22 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
23 of order against such amendments are waived except those
24 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion
25 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee

1 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
2 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
3 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
4 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
5 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
6 structions.

7 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
8 6052 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
9 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
10 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
11 designated by the Speaker.

12 SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-
13 tive day of Thursday, June 26, 2008, for the Speaker to
14 entertain motions that the House suspend the rules relat-
15 ing to:

16 (a) a measure concerning the Commodity Exchange
17 Act and energy markets; and

18 (b) a measure concerning the issuance of oil and gas
19 leases on Federal lands or waters.

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
