11 The Senate amendment and the motion shall be consid-
12 ered as read. The motion shall be debatable for three
13 hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
14 ranking minority member of the Committee on Financial
15 Services. The previous question shall be considered as or-
16 dered on the motion to final adoption without intervening
17 motion.

18 SEC. 2. During consideration of the motion to concur
19 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
20 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further
21 consideration of such motion to such time as may be des-
22 ignated by the Speaker.
