Mr. WELCH of Vermont, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1427) to reform the regulation of certain housing-related Government-sponsored enterprises, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1427) to reform the regulation of
6 certain housing-related Government-sponsored enter-

1 prises, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
2 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
3 consideration of the bill are waived except those arising
4 under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall
5 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
6 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
7 nority member of the Committee on Financial Services.
8 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
9 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
10 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
11 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
12 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
13 Financial Services now printed in the bill, modified by the
14 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
15 Rules accompanying this resolution. That amendment in
16 the nature of a substitute shall be considered by title rath-
17 er than by section. Each title shall be considered as read.
18 All points of order against that amendment in the nature
19 of a substitute are waived except those arising under
20 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11
21 of rule XVIII, no amendment to that amendment in the
22 nature of a substitute shall be in order except those print-
23 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
24 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII before the be-
25 ginning of consideration of the bill and except pro forma

1 amendments for the purpose of debate. Each amendment
2 so printed may be offered only by the Member who caused
3 it to be printed or his designee and shall be considered
4 as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
5 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
6 to the House with such amendments as may have been
7 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
8 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
9 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature
10 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous
11 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
12 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
13 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
14 structions.

15 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
16 1427 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
17 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
18 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
19 designated by the Speaker.
