## RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the United States Postal Service should issue a semipostal stamp to support medical research relating to Alzheimer's disease.

1       *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-  
2       resentatives that the United States Postal Service should,  
3       in accordance with section 416 of title 39, United States  
4       Code—

5               (1) issue a semipostal stamp to support medical  
6       research relating to Alzheimer's disease; and

1           (2) transfer to the National Institutes of Health  
2           for that purpose any amounts becoming available  
3           from the sale of such stamp.
