5 Section 9 of title 4, United States Code, is amended by striking "all persons present" and all that follows 6 through the end and inserting "those present in uniform 7 8 should render the military salute. Members of the Armed 9 Forces and veterans who are present but not in uniform 10 may render the military salute. All other persons present 11 should face the flag and stand at attention with their right 12 hand over the heart, or if applicable, remove their headdress with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, 13 the hand being over the heart. Citizens of other countries 14 15 should stand at attention. All such conduct toward the flag in a moving column should be rendered at the moment 16 17 the flag passes.".
