- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 Section 1 of the Fannie Lou Hamer, Rosa Parks, and
- 5 Coretta Scott King Voting Rights Act Reauthorization
- 6 and Amendments Act of 2006 (Public Law 109–246) is
- 7 amended by striking "and Coretta Scott King" and insert-
- 8 ing "Coretta Scott King, and César E. Chávez".

1 SEC. 2. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.

- 2 Paragraphs (7) and (8) of section 4(a), and section
- 3 13(a)(1), of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.
- 4 1973b(a), 1973k(a)(1)) are each amended by striking
- 5 "and Coretta Scott King" and inserting "Coretta Scott
- 6 King, and César E. Chávez".

7 SEC. 3. CONSTRUCTION.

- 8 Title I of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.
- 9 1973 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 10 lowing:
- "Sec. 20. A reference in this title to the effective date
- 12 of the amendments made by, or the date of the enactment
- 13 of, the Fannie Lou Hamer, Rosa Parks, Coretta Scott
- 14 King, and César E. Chávez Voting Rights Act Reauthor-
- 15 ization and Amendments Act of 2006 shall be considered
- 16 to refer to, respectively, the effective date of the amend-
- 17 ments made by, or the date of the enactment of, the
- 18 Fannie Lou Hamer, Rosa Parks, and Coretta Scott King
- 19 Voting Rights Act Reauthorization and Amendments Act
- 20 of 2006.".
