To expand the boundaries of the Little River Canyon National Preserve in the State of Alabama.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	$tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
3	SECTION 1. LITTLE RIVER CANYON NATIONAL PRESERVE
4	BOUNDARY EXPANSION.
5	Section 2 of the Little River Canyon National Pre-
6	serve Act of 1992 (16 U.S.C. 698q) is amended—
7	(1) in subsection (b)—
8	(A) by striking "The Preserve" and insert-
9	ing the following:
10	"(1) In general.—The Preserve"; and

1	(B) by adding at the end the following:
2	"(2) BOUNDARY EXPANSION.—The boundary of
3	the Preserve is modified to include the land depicted
4	on the map entitled 'Little River Canyon National
5	Preserve Proposed Boundary', numbered 152/
6	80,004, and dated July 31, 2007."; and
7	(2) in subsection (c), by striking "map" and in-
8	serting "maps".
