A BILL

- To require the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation and the United States Geological Survey, to conduct a study on groundwater resources in the State of Alaska, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Alaska Water Re-
 - 5 sources Act of 2007".
 - 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
 - 7 In this Act:

1	(1) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
2	the Secretary of the Interior.
3	(2) STATE.—The term "State" means the State
4	of Alaska.
5	SEC. 3. ALASKA WATER RESOURCES STUDY.
6	(a) Study.—The Secretary, acting through the Com-
7	missioner of Reclamation and the Director of the United
8	States Geological Survey, where appropriate, and in ac-
9	cordance with this Act and other applicable provisions of
10	law, shall conduct a study that includes—
11	(1) a survey of accessible water supplies, includ-
12	ing aquifers, on the Kenai Peninsula, and in the
13	Municipality of Anchorage, the Matanuska-Susitna
14	Borough, the city of Fairbanks, and the Fairbanks
15	Northstar Borough;
16	(2) a survey of water treatment needs and tech-
17	nologies, including desalination, applicable to the
18	water resources of the State; and
19	(3) a review of the need for enhancement of the
20	streamflow information collected by the United
21	States Geological Survey in the State relating to
22	critical water needs in areas such as—
23	(A) infrastructure risks to State transpor-
24	tation,
25	(B) flood forecasting,

1	(C) resource extraction; and
2	(D) fire management.
3	(b) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date
4	of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
5	the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
6	Senate and the Committee on Resources of the House of
7	Representatives a report describing the results of the
8	study required by subsection (a).
9	SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
10	There are authorized to be appropriated such sums

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11 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
