## A BILL

To prohibit the closure or relocation of any county office of the Farm Service Agency until at least one year after the enactment of an Act to provide for the continuation of agricultural programs for fiscal years after 2007.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CLOSURE OR RELOCATION
- 4 OF FARM SERVICE AGENCY COUNTY OF-
- 5 FICES.
- 6 The Secretary of Agriculture may not close or relo-
- 7 cate any county or field office of the Farm Service Agency

- 1 until at least one year after the date of the enactment
- 2 of an omnibus law to provide for the continuation of agri-
- 3 cultural programs for fiscal years after 2007 unless such
- 4 office, for 180 consecutive days during the two-year period
- 5 ending on such date of enactment, had zero employees.
