A BILL

To enhance the ability to combat methamphetamine.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Combat Methamphet-5 amine Enhancement Act of 2007".

6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT OF SELF-CERTIFICATION BY ALL

7 REGULATED PERSONS SELLING SCHEDULED
8 LISTED CHEMICALS.

9 The first sentence of section 310(e)(1)(B)(i) of the
10 Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 830(e)(1)(B)(i)) is
11 amended by striking "A regulated seller" and inserting "A

regulated seller or regulated person referred to in sub section (b)(3)(B)".

3 SEC. 3. PUBLICATION OF SELF-CERTIFIED REGULATED 4 SELLERS AND REGULATED PERSONS LISTS.

5 Section 310(e)(1)(B) of the Controlled Substances
6 Act (21 U.S.C. 830(e)(1)(B)) is amended by inserting at
7 the end the following:

8 "(v) PUBLICATION OF LIST OF SELF-9 CERTIFIED PERSONS.—The Attorney Gen-10 eral shall publish a list of all persons who 11 are currently self-certified in accordance 12 with this section. This list shall be made 13 available on the website of the Drug En-14 forcement Administration.".

15SEC. 4. REQUIREMENT THAT DISTRIBUTORS OF LISTED16CHEMICALS SELL ONLY TO SELF-CERTIFIED17REGULATED SELLERS AND REGULATED PER-18SONS.

19 Section 402(a) of the Controlled Substances Act (21
20 U.S.C. 842(a)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (13), by striking "and" afterthe semicolon;

23 (2) in paragraph (14), by striking the period24 and inserting "; and"; and

25 (3) by inserting at the end the following:

"(15) to distribute a scheduled listed chemical
product to a regulated seller, or to a regulated person referred to in section 310(b)(3)(B) (21 U.S.C.
830(b)(3)(B)), unless such regulated seller or regulated person is, at the time of such distribution, on
the list of persons referred to under section
310(e)(1)(B)(v) (21 U.S.C. 830(e)(1)(B)(v)).".

8 SEC. 5. NEGLIGENT FAILURE TO SELF-CERTIFY AS RE-9 QUIRED.

Section 402(a) of the Controlled Substances Act (21
U.S.C. 842(a)(10)) is amended by inserting before the
semicolon the following: "or negligently to fail to self-certify as required under section 310 (21 U.S.C. 830)".

14 SEC. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall16 take effect 60 days after the date of enactment of this17 Act.
