A BILL

To delay for 6 months the requirement to use of tamper-resistant prescription pads under the Medicaid program.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Patient and Pharmacy
5 Protection Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. 6-MONTH DELAY IN REQUIREMENT TO USE TAM-**
7 **PER-RESISTANT PRESCRIPTION PADS UNDER**
8 **MEDICAID.**

9 Effective as if included in the enactment of section
10 7002(b) of the U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans’ Care,

1 Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations
2 Act, 2007 (Public Law 110–28, 121 Sta. 187), paragraph
3 (2) of such section is amended by striking “September 30,
4 2007” and inserting “March 31, 2008”.

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
