A BILL

To protect privacy and security concerns in court records.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF PRIVACY AND SECURITY CON-**
4 **CERNS IN COURT RECORDS.**

5 Section 7268 of title 38, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding a new section (c) as follows:

7 “(c) PRIVACY AND SECURITY OF ELECTRONIC FIL-
8 INGS.—(1) The Court shall prescribe rules, in accordance
9 with section 7264(a) of this title, to protect privacy and
10 security concerns relating to all filing of documents and
11 the public availability under this subsection of documents

1 retained by the Court or filed electronically with the
2 Court.

3 “(2) Such rules shall be consistent to the extent prac-
4 ticable with rules addressing privacy and security issues
5 throughout the Federal courts.

6 “(3) Such rules shall take into consideration best
7 practices in Federal and State courts to protect private
8 information or otherwise maintain necessary information
9 security.”.

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
