 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Missisquoi and Trout
 - 5 Rivers Wild and Scenic River Study Act of 2007".

1 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION FOR STUDY.

- 2 Section 5(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
- 3 U.S.C. 1276(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 4 lowing:
- 5 "(140) Missisquoi and trout rivers,
- 6 VERMONT.—The segment from the headwaters of
- 7 the rivers downstream to the confluence of that seg-
- 8 ment with the Missisquoi Bay of Lake Champlain.".

9 SEC. 3. STUDY AND REPORT.

- Section 5(b) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
- 11 U.S.C. 1276(b)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 12 lowing:
- 13 "(19) Missisquoi and trout rivers,
- 14 VERMONT.—Not later than 3 years after the date of
- enactment of this paragraph, the Secretary of the
- 16 Interior shall—
- "(A) complete the study of the Missisquoi
- and Trout Rivers, Vermont, described in sub-
- section (a)(140); and
- 20 "(B) submit a report describing the results
- of that study to the appropriate committees of
- Congress.".

1 SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- 2 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
- 3 as are necessary to carry out this Act and the amendments

4 made by this Act.
