A BILL

To amend the Do-Not-Call Implementation Act to eliminate the automatic removal of telephone numbers registered on the Federal “do-not-call” registry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Do-Not-Call Improve-
5 ment Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE FOR REG-**
2 **ISTERED TELEPHONE NUMBERS.**

3 The Do-Not-Call Implementation Act (15 U.S.C.
4 6101 note) is amended—

5 (1) by inserting “Such rule shall not provide
6 any date of expiration for telephone numbers reg-
7 istered on the ‘do-not-call’ registry, nor for any pre-
8 determined time limitation for telephone numbers to
9 remain on the registry.” after the first sentence in
10 section 3; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 **“SEC. 5. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE.**

13 “In issuing regulations regarding the ‘do-not-call’
14 registry of the Telemarketing Sales Rule (16 C.F.R.
15 310.4(b)(1)(iii)), the Federal Trade Commission shall not
16 provide for any date of expiration for telephone numbers
17 registered on the ‘do-not-call’ registry, nor for any pre-
18 determined time limitation for telephone numbers to re-
19 main on the registry.”.
