A BILL

To address emergency shortages in food banks.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY FUNDING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Out of any funds in the Treasury
5 not otherwise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury
6 shall transfer to the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out
7 the emergency food assistance program established under
8 the Emergency Food Assistance Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C.
9 7501 et seq.) \$40,000,000, to remain available until ex-
10 ended.

11 (b) RECEIPT AND ACCEPTANCE.—The Secretary
12 shall be entitled to receive, shall accept, and shall use to

- 1 carry out this section the funds transferred under sub-
- 2 section (a), without further appropriation.
