3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fairness in Housing
5 for Disabled Veterans Act.”

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF ANNUAL INCOME FOR PURPOSES**
2 **OF SECTION 8 AND OTHER PUBLIC HOUSING**
3 **PROGRAMS.**

4 Section 3(b)(4) of the United States Housing Act of
5 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437a(3)(b)(4)) is amended by inserting
6 “or any deferred Department of Veterans Affairs dis-
7 ability benefits that are received in a lump sum amount
8 or in prospective monthly amounts” before “may not be
9 considered”.
