3 **SECTION 1. CONSTRUCTION OF LOW OBSERVABLE COM-**
4 **POSITE REPAIR FACILITY, HOLLOMAN AIR**
5 **FORCE BASE, NEW MEXICO.**

6 (a) PROJECT AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of
7 the Air Force may alter a hangar at Holloman Air Force

1 Base, New Mexico, to construct a Low Observable Com-
2 posite Repair Facility, in the amount of \$14,500,000.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
4 authorized to be appropriated \$14,500,000 for fiscal year
5 2009 for military construction, land acquisition, and mili-
6 tary family housing functions of the Department of the
7 Air Force to carry out the project authorized under sub-
8 section (a).
