Mr. COLEMAN (for himself and Mr. LEVIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow a continuous levy on payments to Medicaid providers and suppliers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid Levy En-  
5 hancement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUOUS LEVY ON PAYMENTS TO MEDICAID**  
7 **PROVIDERS AND SUPPLIERS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6331(h)(2) of the Inter-  
9 nal Revenue Code of 1986 (defining specified payment)  
10 is amended by striking “and” at the end of subparagraph

1 (B), by striking the period at the end of subparagraph  
2 (C) and inserting “, and”, and by adding at the end the  
3 following new subparagraph:

4                   “(D) any payment to any medicaid pro-  
5                   vider or supplier under a State plan under title  
6                   XIX of the Social Security Act.”.

7           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
8 this section shall apply to levies issued after the date of  
9 the enactment of this Act.

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
