A BILL

To require all automobiles manufactured or sold in the United States to be equipped with a real time and average fuel economy display.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAL TIME FUEL ECONOMY DISPLAY.**

4 Section 32908 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(h) REAL TIME FUEL ECONOMY DISPLAY.—Begin-
7 ning with model year 2013, any automobile manufactured
8 or sold in the United States shall be equipped with a real

- 2 is easily visible to the driver of such automobile.”.
