To amend the National Organ Transplant Act to clarify that kidney paired donations shall not be considered to involve the transfer of a human organ for valuable consideration.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Living Kidney Organ
5 Donation Clarification Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE NATIONAL ORGAN TRANS-**
2 **PLANT ACT.**

3 Section 301(a) of the National Organ Transplant Act
4 (42 U.S.C. 274e(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following: “For purposes of this section, kidney paired do-
6 nations shall not be considered to involve the transfer of
7 a human organ for valuable consideration.”.
