Mr. KOHL (for himself and Mr. LEAHY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To amend the Organic Foods Production Act of 1990 to prohibit the labeling of cloned livestock and products derived from cloned livestock as organic.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF CLONED LIVESTOCK.**

4 Section 2103 of the Organic Foods Production Act
5 of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 6502) is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (6) through
7 (21) as paragraphs (7) through (22) respectively;
8 and

1 (2) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
 2 lowing:

3 “(6) CLONED LIVESTOCK.—The term ‘cloned
 4 livestock’ means—

5 “(A) livestock produced as the result of so-
 6 matic cell nuclear transfer or other asexual re-
 7 production technologies; and

8 “(B) the progeny of such livestock.”.

9 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR ORGANIC PRODUC-**
 10 **TION.**

11 Section 2105 of the Organic Foods Production Act
 12 of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 6504) is amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
 14 end;

15 (2) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-
 16 graph (4); and

17 (3) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
 18 lowing:

19 “(3) not be cloned livestock, or produced or de-
 20 rived from or containing any part of cloned livestock;
 21 and”.
