A BILL

To make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands
Pass available at a discount to certain veterans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Eagle Parks
- 5 Pass Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. VETERANS NATIONAL PARKS AND FEDERAL REC-
- 7 REATIONAL LANDS PASS.
- 8 Section 805(b) of division J of the Consolidated Ap-
- 9 propriations Act, 2005 (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)), is amended
- 10 by adding at the end the following:

1	"(3) Veterans discount.—
2	"(A) In general.—Th

"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available, at a cost of \$10, to any veteran who was separated from military service under conditions other than dishonorable, if the veteran provides proof of the status by presenting a DD214.

"(B) TERM.—A National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass issued under this paragraph shall be valid for 1 year after the date of issuance of the pass.".
