A BILL

To provide adequate funding for local governments harmed by Hurricane Katrina of 2005 or Hurricane Rita of 2005.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Local Government Dis-
5 aster Relief Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL SHARE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, the Federal share of any assistance provided
9 under section 406 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-
10 lief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5172) be-

1 cause of Hurricane Katrina of 2005 or Hurricane Rita
2 of 2005 shall be 100 percent.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply to
4 any assistance provided under section 406 of the Robert
5 T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 5172) on or after August 28, 2005.
