Mr. SCHUMER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of section  
5 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1151), Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical shall be considered  
7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for  
8 permanent residence as of the date of enactment of this  
9 Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
12 Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical, the Secretary of State

1 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the  
2 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of  
3 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the  
4 country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) or 203(a)  
5 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1152(e), 1153(a)).
