A BILL

For the relief of Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of section
- 5 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1151), Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical shall be considered
- 7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
- 8 permanent residence as of the date of enactment of this
- 9 Act upon payment of the required visa fees.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to
- 12 Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical, the Secretary of State

- 1 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the
- 2 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of
- 3 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the
- 4 country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) or 203(a)
- 5 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.

6 1152(e), 1153(a)).
