To amend the Torture Victims Relief Act of 1998 to authorize assistance for domestic and foreign programs and centers for the treatment of victims of torture, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Torture Victims Relief
- 5 Reauthorization Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY.
- 7 It is the policy of the United States—

- 1 (1) to ensure that, in providing United States 2 support abroad for programs and centers for the treatment of victims of torture, particular incentives 3 and support should be given to establishing and sup-5 porting such programs and centers in emerging de-6 mocracies, in post-conflict environments, and, with a view to providing services to refugees and internally 7 8 displaced persons, in areas as close to ongoing con-9 flicts as safely as possible; and
- 10 (2) to ensure that, in providing United States 11 support for domestic programs and centers for the 12 treatment of victims of torture, particular attention 13 should be given to regions with significant immi-14 grant or refugee populations.
