- 7 at the end the following:
- 8 "(d) Treatment of Indian Tribes as Corpora-
- 9 TIONS.—

"(2) Treatment of members as stockHolders.—In applying this subsection, a member
of an unincorporated Indian tribe shall be treated in
the same manner as a stockholder of a corporation.".

9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by 10 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any election that 11 occurs after December 31, 2007.
