## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Rotunda of the Capitol to be used on March 29, 2007, for a ceremony to award the Congressional Gold Medal to the Tuskegee Airmen.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2   *concurring)*, That the Rotunda of the Capitol is authorized  
3 to be used on March 29, 2007, for a ceremony to award  
4 a Congressional Gold Medal collectively to the Tuskegee  
5 Airmen in accordance with Public Law 109–213. Physical  
6 preparations for the ceremony shall be carried out in ac-  
7 cordance with such conditions as the Architect of the Cap-  
8 itol may prescribe.
